With just weeks remaining - there is still time to help us purchase our theater home debt free.

On behalf of the entire membership I want to thank our supporters for their generosity to our organization. And thanks to our volunteers who have dedicated countless hours to make it possible for us to purchase our theater home. In a world that is looking for examples of true community - it can be found here on the North Fork of Long Island at the NFCT. Along with a group of optimistic volunteers who had an undying faith that it could be done! And those volunteers are the true strength and wealth of the NFCT.




Luke Sisson (Sailor)- Luke is happy to be a part of his sixth Youth on Stage production. He desperately hopes you enjoy the show.


